Points Of Interest

Daytrips—Combine a stained glass trip with some Kansas culture

Cloud County has been officially designated the Stained Glass Capital of Kansas by the Kansas Legislature. Call 785-243-2553 to request their stained glass tour map. The Cloud County Fair is July 19th-23rd in Concordia.

See the beautiful scene which Bill Kurtis commissioned from Rayer's Bearden Stained Glass. It has been installed in the Art of the Prairie Gallery, located on Main Street in Sedan. The Chautauqua County Fair will be held July 27th-30th in Sedan.

See the restoration work completed by Dale Lott, owner of Wichita Stained Glass, on the windows of the St. Fidelis Church in Victoria, better known as the Cathedral of the Plains. Ellis County, German Capital of Kansas, is hosting it's 23rd Annual Herzogfest in Victoria on August 12th & 13th.

Kansas University in Lawrence is home to the Robert J. Dole Institute of Politics, which houses exhibits and papers from former Sen. Bob Dole's political career. Located in the Institute is a powerful September 11 Memorial, that has as it's backdrop a 36-foot-tall stained glass flag, considered to be the largest stained glass flag in the world. Also in the Institute is a 22-foot-tall window depicting Sen. Dole's hometown of Russell and the Kansas prairie. Open to the public daily, visit
