Krylon has developed several new products that

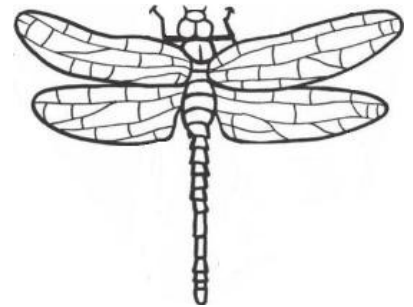
